Daniel Scholl - Administrative Advisor update:

House Appropriations Ag Subcommittee – voted to restore NIFA formula funds to the FY12 level (rather than the 7.5% reduction in the current year) in FY14. Although the President had asked for a much larger increase in AFRI funding, the House subcommittee version includes a 10% increase to AFRI funding.

An Impact Statement extremely important for mid-term review. These statements can be widely used to demonstrate the value and impact of multistate committee.

Treatments are 7-day CIDR vs. control (nothing), both groups natural service Cows used would be late-calving cows in producer herds. We would try and document:

Calving date Cow age (typically based on tag numbering system or age brand) Cow condition scores Actual weaning weight Calculate adjusted 205 ww based on average birth weight. Fall preg test? Subsequent actual birth dates on test cows.
