Brief summary of minutes of annual meeting:

The 2018 NC-1177 meetings were held October 9th and 10th in St. Louis, Missouri. A part of the meeting was held jointly with the National Agricultural Credit Committee (NACC). The NACC is comprised of agricultural lenders from throughout the U.S. The meeting allowed members of NC-1177 to interact with these representatives and better understand how the group's research intersects with the issues faced by agricultural and rural lenders.

The joint component included presentations on financing and commodity market outlooks, export markets and risk, agricultural finance, as well as two panels that were comprised of lenders, agribusiness executives, and participants from the NC-1177 meetings. Speakers for these topics included representatives from the Farm Credit System, Rabo Agrifinance, First State Bank and Trust Company, Inc., USDA Economic Research Service, and Informa Agribusiness Intelligence. During the NC-1177 portion of the meeting, members discussed the group's research projects and progress and presented completed and ongoing research.

The NC-1177 business meeting included updates on the Agricultural Finance and Management (AFM) Section of the Agricultural and Applied Economics Association (AAEA), fellow research group activities, organizing research for upcoming conferences, member publication activity, along with reporting requirements for the upcoming year. The meeting concluded with discussion of the location and dates for the 2019 annual meeting. The group agreed to continue to hold the meetings jointly with the fall meeting of the National Ag Credit Committee. Wendong Zhang (Iowa State University) was unanimously elected as the new Secretary/President-Elect on the executive committee for 2019. Continuing members are Brady Brewer (President) and Elizabeth Yeager (Past-President).
